Have you had a reduction in hours or have you been temporarily laid off?

- EDD Work Sharing Unemployment Insurance (UI) Program allows for payment of UI benefits to individuals whose wages and hours have been reduced. It is considered a temporary and practical alternative to layoffs, allowing businesses to retain quality employees, while reducing business payroll burden and allowing them to supplement employee wages during this time.

Have you been permanently laid off?

- **File for Unemployment Insurance (UI).** UI rules and restrictions are being eased during this time so you may qualify, even if you have been denied in the past.
